*Planning permissions – we had discussion, debate and decisions made on applications at Fox Covert Farm – which was disappointingly a Retrospective application, Burketts Farm and Hill Farm.* 

Maintenance of our assets with inspection's, works and purchases to our defibrillator, notice boards, dog and grit bins and allotments. On the Charitable Recreation Grounds Assets we have maintained the Recreation Ground, thank you to Shaun, hedge planting and plan to fence and gate the lands from the village hall car park to protect the grounds in wet weather.

Community Rest Centre was inspected and refreshed where necessary.

Pothole's, parking around the Hares Lane Junction and flooding around the village were also topical during the year, with use being made of the Suffolk County Council Highways web page to identify the issue and get repaired.

The Annual Internal Audit, Accountability and Governance Review, was successfully signed off by our newly appointed internal auditor, Tony Brown who was doing the job for the first time. This Work was all completed on time. Budgeting, Costs, Annual Precept and Accounts review work was diligently carried out on time.

We would like to thank our Suffolk County Councillor Annette Dunning and East Suffolk District Councillor Tony Goldson for their kind donations towards our Platinum Jubilee celebrations.
